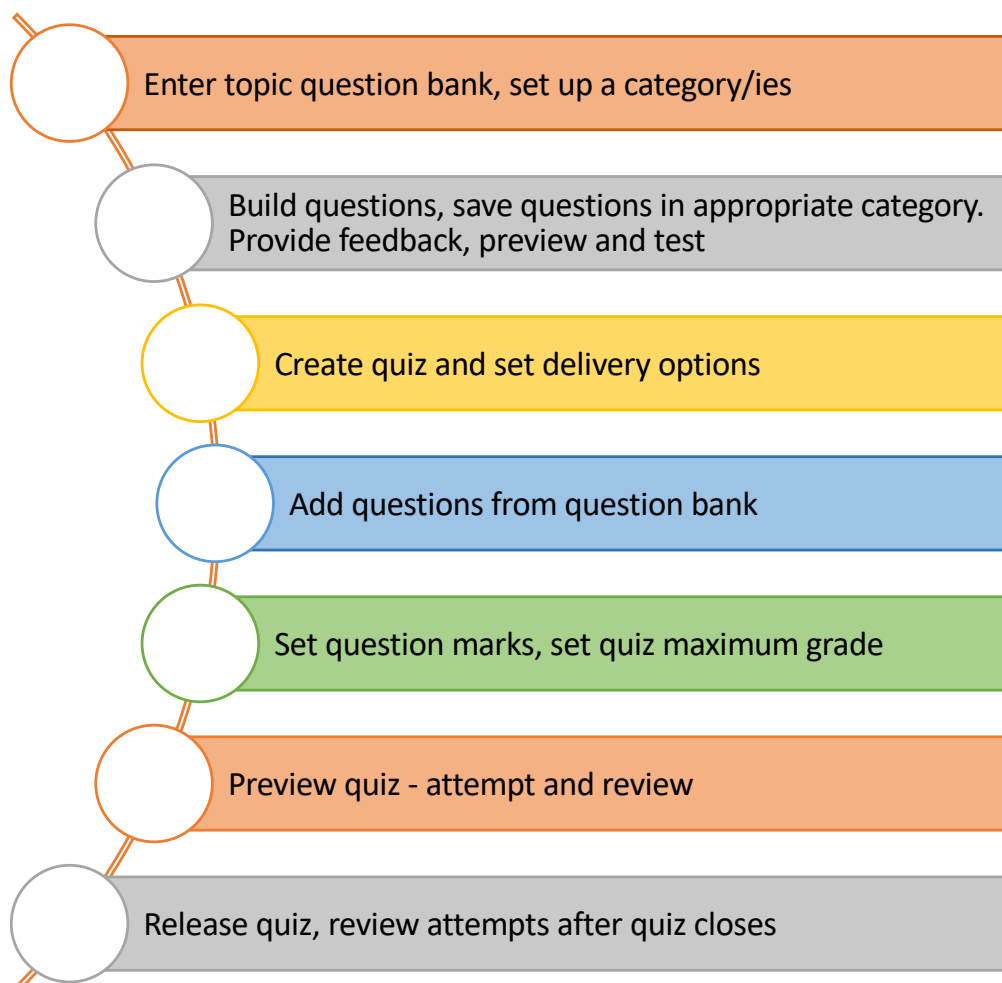


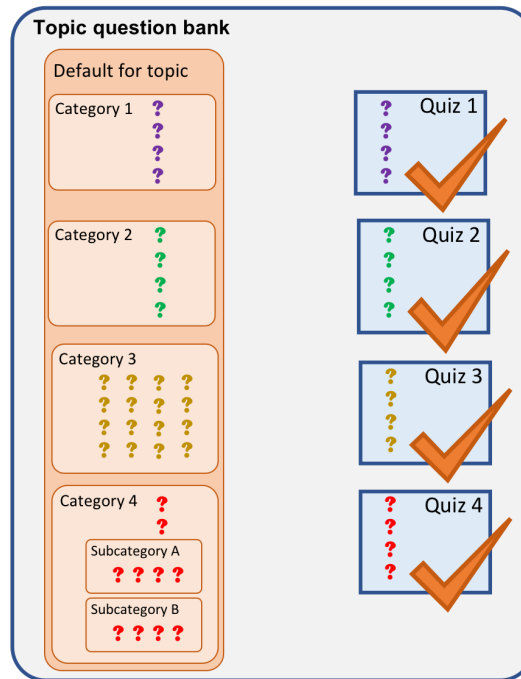
Quizzes & question banks – key concepts


- **Question banks** store and organise questions, using **categories**
- **Quizzes** deliver questions and contain the settings for the quiz including:
 - Question order, question behavior (shuffling answer option)
 - Quiz availability times & number of attempts
 - Quiz time limit
 - Grade settings
 - Review options
- **Questions** can be used in multiple quizzes when stored in the **topic** question bank
- Quizzes can deliver designated questions, **random questions** from a **category/subcategory**, or a combination of set and random questions
 - When using random questions from a category/subcategory, all questions in that category are candidates

Creating quiz - workflow

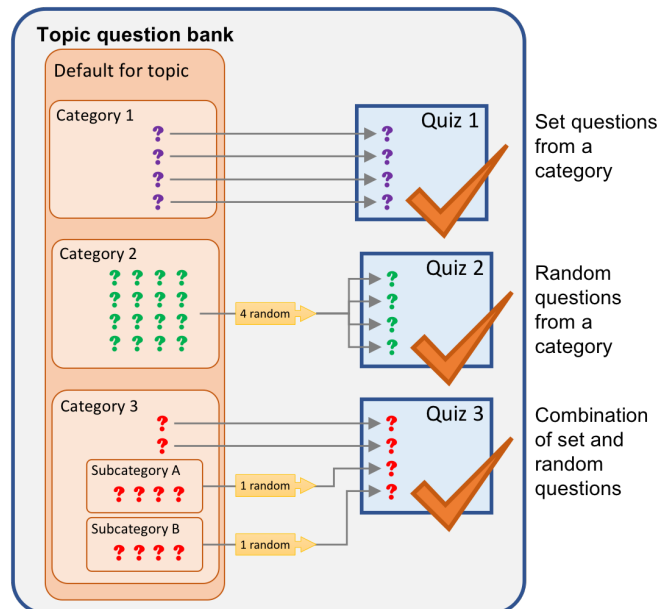



Use categories and subcategories to organise your questions



 Question titles are not displayed to users taking a quiz. Use quiz titles as an organizational aid

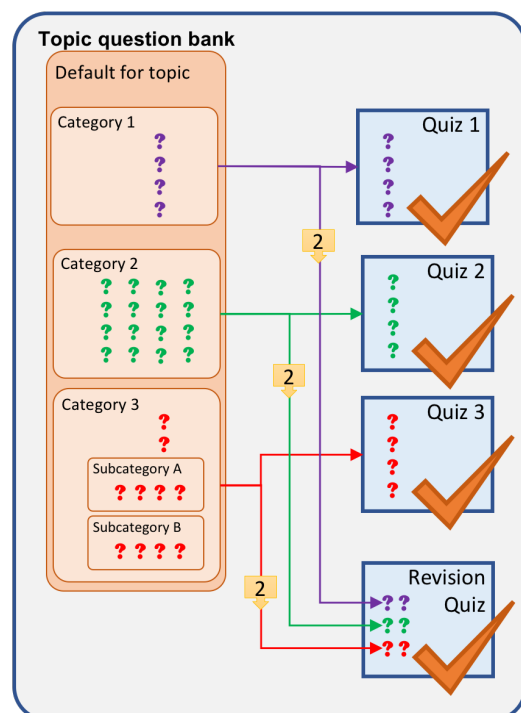
A quiz can have specified questions, random questions from a category, or a combination




 Create multiple questions around each concept covered by your quiz and store in subcategories. Set the quiz to deliver random questions from each subcategory. This will ensure that every student will answer the same number of questions on each concept.

Duplicate then edit questions to rapidly build sets of similar questions.

Re-use questions in multiple quizzes



 Create a revision quiz using random questions from your weekly quizzes. Allow unlimited attempts. Students will get different questions on each attempt.
